

How to earn “SCRIP” Points (and \$\$) for Windsor Presbyterian Church

Updated - March 3, 2015

For most merchants, you need to **go to the store** to join their rewards programs– Safeway “Club Card”, Raley’s “Something Extra”, Oliver’s or Molsberry “Community Card”*

Then go to a website to register your charitable preference.

- 1) **Raleys.com** - Create an account/register your card
 - a) Look for link to “extra credit”
 - b) choose Windsor Presbyterian Church as your charity of choice.
- 2) **Escrip.com** – create an account /register your cards:
 - a) **Safeway** – register Club Card
 - (i) must renew annually at escrip.com
 - (ii) no points for CREDIT CARD purchases
 - b) **Molsberry or Olivers** - Register Community Card
 - c) To earn points from **Online** merchants like **Amazon.com, Homedepot.com**, & 798 others, follow the links FROM escrip.com to their websites. You don’t have to register anything.
 - d) **Big O Tires, Fircrest Market** & a few others– register Credit/Debit Cards on escrip.com, then use that card at the retail location.

**Community Cards are good only at the merchant you obtained it from, so if you want to earn points at both Molsberrys –and- Olivers you’ll need to get two Community cards.*

- Register Cards on websites, choosing WPC as beneficiary
